



Ashby Legacy Fund Scholarship Program Overview

Introduction

The Scholarship Program of Ashby Legacy Fund encourages future generations to pursue and achieve an impactful post-secondary education, while removing common barriers to them realizing their unlimited potential and impact within the Ashby community.

Eligibility and Criteria

To be eligible to apply, students must be enrolled in the Ashby Legacy Fund Scholarship Program, graduating Ashby Public Schools, and have an accrued potential scholarship balance.

Awardees will be selected based on:

- Maintaining passing grades
- Demonstrating school and community pride through participation in volunteer and fundraising activities
- Holding themselves to high standards through their behavior and leadership at school

Process

To be considered, applicants must submit complete application packets by May 1st. Applications will be reviewed by the Ashby Legacy Fund Scholarship Committee. Awardees will be announced at Sr. Awards Day in May.

Scholarship packets must include the following:

- A completed application form
- High school transcript

Scholarship amounts and payment process

Awarded scholarships will not exceed the balance of potential scholarship accrued by the student through their participation in the Ashby Legacy Fund Scholarship Program. In addition, no student shall be awarded a scholarship in excess of the school's established educational expenses.

To be eligible for payment of their scholarship a scholarship, program participants must enroll and attend post-secondary education at a 2-year or 4-year college/university, vocational/technical college, or other accredited post-secondary institution within two (2) years of graduating from high school. If a student opts to enlist in any branch of the military, disbursement of funds may be reserved for up to two (2) years past the date of honorable discharge. Once awarded, scholarship funds will be disbursed directly to the student's post-secondary institution. Students awarded scholarships must provide the institution's name and financial aid office's contact information, a transcript detailing enrollment for the year as well as the student's grades, and student's school ID number in order to have scholarship funds disbursed.
